MAKE IT EASIER FOR USERS TO FIND AND USE MUSE



LIBRARY | TECHNICAL SERVICES:

- Load MARC and KBART records into your ILS or discovery system
- Turn on MUSE collections in your discovery system.
- Update the description of MUSE on your A-Z database guide:

Project MUSE ebooks and ejournals provide full-text current and archival content from 700+ scholarly journals and 73,000+ ebooks in the humanities and social sciences from major university presses and scholarly societies. The database is updated continually.

LIBRARY | INTER-LIBRARY LOAN:

 The MUSE license allows ILL for MUSE content that is subscribed or purchased.

LIBRARY | BIBLIOGRAPHIC INSTRUCTION/OUTREACH

- Update MUSE descriptions in LibGuides, in the library catalog, and on subject based resource lists
- <u>Display and distribute MUSE logos and free promotional materials</u> (available in both print and electronic formats)
- Follow MUSE on social media and then share articles of interest on the library's social platforms to promote content to specific audiences

LIBRARY | COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT:

- Sign up to receive news and information about MUSE
- MUSE content strengths include: literature, history, performing arts, area studies, education, philosophy & religion, political science, gender studies, as well as the contemporary topics your users are seeking.
- Create a MyMUSE account to receive content alerts for books and journals by publisher or discipline

LIBRARY | ACCESS SERVICES:

- Alumni access is allowed under the MUSE license
- Remote access is available by IP, referring URL, proxy server, and domain paired with an individual's MyMUSE account

UNDERGRADUATES | TUTORIALS:

Point them to User Guides and Research Help

FACULTY AND INSTRUCTORS | PROMOTE MUSE:

- Promote MyMUSE accounts as a way to receive content alerts, create saved searches, save content, and export citations
- Make sure instructors know they can put links to MUSE content in their course management systems (CMS)
- Point to the resources on the <u>For Instructors page</u>
