



# Project MUSE Journal Collections

Project MUSE journal collections are available to institutions for subscription access. Select from among four curated, interdisciplinary collections designed for the specific needs and budgets of various kinds of academic and research institutions, or subscribe to one or both of MUSE's discipline-specific collections, created to address the needs of specialist institutions. Six smaller subject-specific collections are also available to libraries outside of the USA and Canada. Libraries with a current subscription to a MUSE Journal Collection enjoy access to all available volumes of the journals included in their collection, so long as their subscription remains active.

We are happy to help libraries evaluate which of our collections is most appropriate for you. Our tiered pricing is designed to make MUSE accessible to a wide variety of institutions around the globe. Academic library pricing outside of the USA and Canada is based on World Bank income groups, along with other factors unique to each institution. Very cost-effective subscriptions are offered for public and special libraries.

*Subscriptions to the Journal Collections operate on a calendar year term; all subscriptions expire on December 31. Subscriptions beginning after January 31 are pro-rated for the remainder of the calendar year term, and there are no rolling subscription terms. Free 45-day trial access is offered to institutions considering a MUSE Journal Collection subscription. Consortium subscription arrangements are available.*

## Interdisciplinary Collections

### Premium Collection

MUSE's foremost collection of high quality, interdisciplinary journals and the most comprehensive collection offered. The Premium Collection supports the collection development and research needs of major research institutions and grows annually with the addition of selectively chosen journals.

### Standard Collection

A subset of the Premium Collection that offers institutions the interdisciplinary content consistent with their collection development needs yet ensures controlled annual growth.

### Basic Research Collection

A more limited subset of the Premium Collection offering a fundamental collection of interdisciplinary journals that grows modestly in size each year making it an appropriate collection for institutions with limited budgets.

### Basic College Collection

The smallest interdisciplinary subset of the Premium Collection, with modest annual growth and designed for four and two year colleges.

## Discipline-Specific Collections

### Humanities Collection

A subset of the Premium Collection providing a highly relevant set of research journals for art schools, museums, performing arts organizations, film schools, and related institutions.

### Social Sciences Collection

A subset of the Premium Collection designed to meet the needs of special libraries such as think tanks, government agencies, non-governmental organizations, research institutes, and related organizations.

## Subject Collections

### Arts Collection

This collection includes Art, Music, Film, Theater, and Performing Arts. Journals related to performance aspects of literary figures (i.e. Shakespeare).

### Asian Studies Collection

This collection includes journals related to Asia and the Pacific, including the diaspora.

### History Collection

This collection includes all aspects of history, including history of science and technology.

### Literature Core Collection

This collection is a core grouping of MUSE literature titles plus general literature titles. Drama that is treated as literature and not performance is included.

### Literature Expanded Collection

This collection offers a more in-depth collection of MUSE literature titles, including single-author journals and journals focused on a region, language or time period.

### Philosophy & Religion Collection

This collection includes philosophy and religion with some history content as it applies to religious organizations.
